August 26, 1934 - January 1, 2012

Betty Eileen Stephan, age 77, of Huntington, died at 2:35 a.m. Sunday (January 1, 2012) at Peabody Retirement Community in North Manchester.

Betty was born August 26, 1934 in Huntington, the daughter of Emerson and Edith (Quinn) Rittenhouse. Betty married Carl L. Stephan on July 14, 1950 in Andrews. He preceded her in death on December 11, 1998.

Betty farmed along side her husband in Polk Township, cooked at Kermitt's Food Shop in Andrews and worked in production at General Tire in Wabash. She played piano and was a member of the Church of the Brethren in Andrews.
