October 1, 1921 - January 12, 2012

Vivian M. Hiner, age 90, of Huntington, died at 2:15 p.m. Thursday (January 12, 2012) at The Heritage of Huntington.

Vivian was born on October 1, 1921 in Bippus, the daughter of Owen and Delia (Denney) Burkart. She was a 1939 graduate of Andrews High School. Vivian married Marion H. Hiner on May 18, 1943 in Bippus. He preceded her in death on September 14, 2004.

Vivian farmed along side her husband on their Township Farm and worked at Coil Engineering in Roanoke. She was a 50 year member of the Evangelical United Methodist Church where she belonged to the United Methodist Women and was active with the Bippus Lions Club.

Vivian is survived by a daughter - Susan K. (John) Meyer of Huntington; one son - Steven J. (Barbara) Hiner of Huntington; three sisters - Loveta Hartle of Huntington, Veva Schilling of Fort Wayne and Barbara Beckwith of Fort Wayne; one brother - C. Keith Burkart of Huntington; 5 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren. Her parents, husband, sister - Betty Jane Burkart, and one brother - Kenneth Burkart preceded her in death.

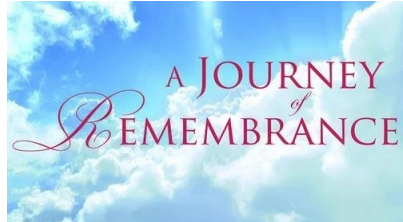
