



## Alice C. Sell

February 14, 1931 - September 6, 2025

Alice C. Sell, 94, of Huntington, passed away at 11:39 pm Saturday, September 6, 2025, at her residence.

Alice was born on February 14, 1931, in New Point, IN, the daughter of Fred Meyer and Ethel (Miller) Meyer. She graduated from Napoleon High School with the class of 1949. Alice continued her education at Ball State University where she received her Bachelors and Masters degree in Education. Alice met Jack G. Sell while at Ball State University, they married on December 27, 1952, in Greensburg, IN; he preceded her in death on December 10, 2019. She retired from Huntington County Community School Corporation after 39 years of service.

Alice and Jack were both very passionate about serving the community and volunteering wherever they were needed. She was a part of the Huntington County Retired Teachers Association, Forks of the Wabash Board, very active at New Hope United Church of Christ, and several other groups.
