Anita Marie Huerta (Choiniere), 58, was welcomed into Heaven at 1:04 a.m. on November 19, 2012 at Parkview Huntington Hospital. She was born in Peoria, Illinois where she graduated from Richwoods High School. Anita went on to work at Proctor Hospital as a Respiratory Therapist. It was while she was working at the hospital where she met and married her soul mate and husband, José Huerta. They were married on May 1, 1982 and last celebrated their 30th wedding anniversary.

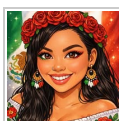
