Ann Wiley Davis, age 74, of Huntington, died at 3:46 p.m. Wednesday (October 19, 2011) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Ann was born June 21, 1937, in Noble County, the daughter of Frank and Harriett (Wiley) Prickett. She graduated from Wolfe Lake High School in 1955. Ann married William "Bill" Davis on September 27, 1975, in Huntington.

Ann retired in 1999 as an Investment Administrator for Lincoln Life, Fort Wayne, after 28 years of service. She was an avid reader, a big Indiana University fan and she loved to travel. Ann was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother.
