March 2, 1921 - October 2, 2014

Anna A. Baumgardner, age 93, of Huntington, died at 2:35 p.m. Thursday (October 2, 2014) at her home.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Monday (October 6, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday (October 7, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Richard Strick officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the funeral service. Burial will be in Star of Hope Cemetery in Huntington County.

Anna was born on March 2, 1921 in Huntington, the daughter of Robert Franklin and Floe Ethel (Miller) Dalrymple. Anna graduated from Huntington High School in 1939. She married Earl Eugene Baumgardner on September 17, 1943 in Fort Wayne, and he preceded her in death on January 29, 1977. She worked at Wabash Magnetic in Huntington and retired from E-Systems in Huntington after 19 years of service. She was a member of Bethel United Brethren Church in Huntington. Anna was also a member of VFW Post #2689 Ladies Auxiliary in Huntington as well as Royal Neighbors of America.
