Annabelle G. Poe, age 82, of Huntington, died at 12:42 a.m. Friday (February 26, 2016) at Miller's Merry Manor in Huntington.

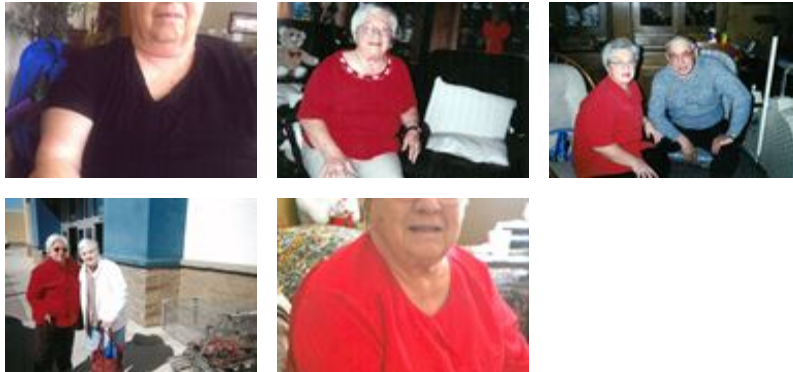
