Anne E. Malone, 81, of Huntington, passed away at 12:20 am Friday, January 12, 2024, at Stillwater Hospice Home in Fort Wayne, IN.

Anne was born on September 15, 1942, in Huntington, IN, the daughter of H. Willard Hildebrand and Anna (Benson) Hildebrand. She graduated from Huntington Township School with the class of 1960 and received an associate degree in nursing from Huntington College. Anne married the love of her life Donald R. Malone on April 8, 1962, in Huntington, IN. They shared 59 years of marriage before he preceded her in death on October 2, 2021. Anne held many positions for Huntington County Government including Huntington County Clerk. She was a dedicated member and Leader of Women's Fellowship at St. Peter's First Community Church of Huntington. Anne was active in the Red Hat Society, Huntington County Democratic Party Women's Caucus, AIC Member, past President of Indiana Clerks Association and past President of her sorority ESA.

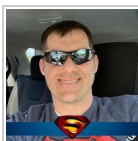
