Audrey I. Stanley, age 79, of Huntington, died at 6:05 a.m. Thursday (March 17, 2011) at Norwood Health and Rehabilitation Center, Huntington.

Audrey was born February 24, 1932, in Huntington County, the daughter of Carl L. and Bernice (Garber) Fitch. She graduated from Andrews High School in 1950. Audrey married Paul Fritz Stanley, March 31, 1951, on a Dallas Township Farm in Huntington County and he survives.

Audrey worked as a bookkeeper at the Kroger Warehouse in Fort Wayne for 12 years. She was a lifetime member of the Pilchers Chapel Church where she played the organ and piano.
