Barbara Ann Topp, age 68, of Huntington, died at 7:05 p.m. Wednesday, June 29, 2016 at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

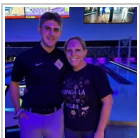

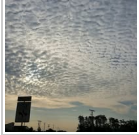
