Betty J. Broxon, 95, of Huntington, passed away at 11:42 pm Saturday, January 22, 2022 at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Betty was born on December 11, 1926 in Huntington, IN, the daughter of Leo Sands and Marie (Fanning) Sands. She graduated from Huntington Township High School in 1945 and married John Omer Broxon on December 28, 1946 in Huntington, IN. He preceded her in death on February 17, 2006.
