Betty L. Dillon, 74, of Huntington, died Wednesday (June 22, 2011) at 2:48 p.m. at the Visiting Nurse & Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Betty was born on April 23, 1937, the daughter of Harold and Audrey (Lincicome) Ethell, in Zanesville, Ohio. She was a 1955 graduate of Jefferson High School in Dresden, Ohio. Betty married Glenn C. Dillon on June 3, 1956 in Dresden.

Betty was the secretary for the Huntington Church of Brethren from 1983 - 2011. She was a very active member of the Church of the Brethren serving as a deacon, singing in the choir and member of the Women's Fellowship. Betty volunteered and served on the board of Love, INC. She was also a member of Beta Sigma Phi Sorority.

Betty is survived by her husband of 55 years - Glenn C. Dillon of Huntington; three sons - Robert E. (Charlotte) Dillon of Huntington, Richard A. (Joyce) Dillon of Huntington and Michael D. (Paula) Dillon of Fort Wayne; one brother - Donald R. (Mary) Ethell of Dresden, Ohio; seven grandchildren and ten great grandchildren. Her parents preceded her in death.
