Betty Jean Korreckt, age 86, of Huntington, died at 8:20 p.m. Monday (September 28, 2015) at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

There will be no visitation or funeral services. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County at a later date.
