



## Betty R. Shaw

June 24, 1923 - April 25, 2011

Betty R. Shaw, age 87, of Warren, died at 1:30 p.m. Monday (April 25, 2011) at her home in Warren.

Betty was born June 24, 1923, in Huntington, the daughter of George and LaRuey (King) Thorne. She graduated from Jefferson Township High School in 1942. Betty married Roger D. Shaw on December 20, 1944, in Warren. He preceded her in death on February 20, 2005.

Betty retired from the Huntington County Community School Corporation where she worked in the cafeterias. She also worked at the former Morrison's Restaurant in Warren. Betty attended the Jefferson United Methodist Church and was active with the Huntington County 4-H Fair in which she served on the Board for over 20 years and helped with many auctions.
