Betty J. (Campbell) Dalrymple, age 86, of Huntington, died at 2:55 p.m. Wednesday (November 11, 2009) at Parkview Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Betty was born on June 19, 1923 in Salamonia (Jay County), Indiana to Raymond O. and Eliza M. (Rush) Campbell. She graduated in 1941 from P.A. Allen High School in Bluffton. Betty married Bryce H. Dalrymple on June 24, 1943 in Huntington. Bryce preceded her in death on March 25, 1992.
