Beulah J. King, age 89, 7616 West 900 North, Huntington, died at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday (January 28, 2009) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Mrs. King was a homemaker and farmed along side of her husband. Beulah was a resident of Huntington County for most of her life. She attended the New Hope Ministries Church in Huntington. Most of Beulah's active life was devoted to caring for the family but she also loved the church, working the garden, and reading. She will be sadly missed by all who knew her.

Beulah was born on December 31, 1919 in Wabash County, to Floyd and Irene (Fisher) Grossman, the oldest of four children. She graduated from Lagro High School and on April 27, 1941, she married Delbert L. King in Wabash County.
