Brian K. Jones, age 49, of Roanoke, died at 7:37 p.m. Wednesday, (December 31, 2014) at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be held from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Monday (January 5, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday (January 6, 2015) at Roanoke Baptist Church, 11015 Lafayette Center Road, Roanoke, Indiana, with Pastor Mike Tarr officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the funeral service. Burial will be in Glenwood Cemetery in Roanoke.

Brian was born on September 25, 1965 in Cheyenne, Wyoming, the son of Monte and Crystal (Duff) Jones. He graduated in 1983 from Knob Noster High School in Missouri and served in the United States Navy. He married Nancy L. Becker on June 3, 1986 in Missouri. Brian worked at ITT Industries in Fort Wayne for 26 years. He was a member of Roanoke Baptist Church. Brian was involved in many outreach ministries, and he loved woodworking, especially making things for others.

Brian is survived by his wife of 28 years - Nancy L. Jones of Roanoke; his

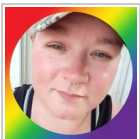

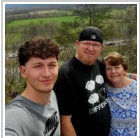
