



## Carl E. Hoag

March 6, 1941 - November 8, 2014

Carl E. Hoag, age 73, of Huntington, died at 4:00 p.m. Saturday (November 8, 2014) at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be held from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Wednesday (November 12, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday (November 13, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Tom Bradley officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the funeral service. Burial will be in Pilgrims Rest Cemetery in Huntington with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

Carl was born March 6, 1941 in Huntington, the son of Guy Robert and Pauline (Hasty) Hoag Biddle. He was a 1959 graduate of Huntington High School and he served in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War. He married Evangeline "Vangie" Hamman on November 19, 1966 in Huntington. He retired from K-Mart in Manteno, Illinois after 32 years of service. Following retirement, he worked for Wal-Mart for two years and for Bendix in Huntington for eight years. Carl was a member of Etna Avenue Wesleyan Church in Huntington, where he taught Sunday school.

Carl is survived by his wife of 47 years - Vangie Hoag of Huntington; two daughters - Dawn (Bill) Lortie of Albion and Jodi (Todd) Duke of Adamsville, Tennessee; six grandchildren - Justin Lortie, Trevor Lortie, Shelby Lortie, Hunter Duke, Chase Duke, Dakota Duke; and one great grandson - Roman Carroll. He is preceded in death by his parents and sister - Janet Jean Hoag.

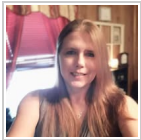
