Carol S. Stonebraker, age 70, of Roanoke, died at 5:42 p.m. Sunday (April 17, 2016) at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne.

There will be no visitation or funeral services.

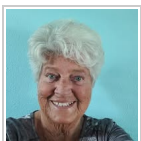

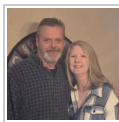
