Carolyn "Kelly" Dawn Beasey, 79, of Huntington, passed away at 12:09 pm Monday, December 15, 2025 at Heritage Pointe of Fort Wayne.

Kelly was born on April 19, 1946 in St. Louis, MO, the daughter of John Case and Alice "Dawn" (Ross) Case. She graduated from Highland High School with the Class of 1964 and married Ray Allen Beasey on May 8, 1965 in Albuquerque, NM; He preceded her in death on December 19, 2020. Yes, her name was really Carolyn, but she would not answer to it. She was known as Kelly for her whole life.
