



Charles F. "Chuck" Stanley

June 3, 1928 - January 8, 2017

Charles F. "Chuck" Stanley, age 88, of Bluffton, formerly of Huntington, died at 6:45 a.m. Sunday, January 8, 2017 at River Terrace Retirement Community in Bluffton.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Wednesday, January 11, 2017 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday, January 12, 2017 at Christ the King Episcopal Church, 1224 North Jefferson Street, Huntington, with Fathers Ted Neidlinger and Larry Biller officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by American Legion Post #85 of Huntington.

He married Shirley M. Meree on June 8, 1951 in Charleston, South Carolina. Chuck worked as the Operations Coordinator at United REMC, retiring in 1990 after 36 years of service. He was a member of Christ the King Episcopal Church, American Legion Post

#85, and Moose Lodge #837 in Huntington. He loved to golf and was a handyman who could fix anything.

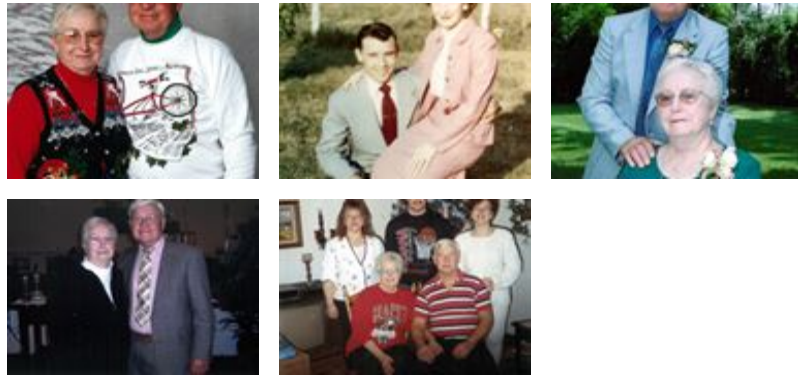
