



Charlie Cox Sr.

February 21, 1930 - April 9, 2011

Charlie Cox, Sr., age 81, of Huntington, died at 1:07 p.m. Saturday (April 9, 2011) at the Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Charlie was born on February 21, 1930, in Garrett, Kentucky, the son of Patton and Amy (Gayhart) Cox. On October 15, 1949, he married Roseann K. Biehl in Huntington. She preceded him in death.

Charlie was the owner of Huntington Seamless Guttering for 26 years. He also owned and operated the Goodyear Tire Store for 16 years. Charlie was a member of Christ the King Episcopal Church, serving as the Senior Warden for over 30 years, and the Moose Lodge #834 both in Huntington. During the former Mayor Gene Snowden Administration, he served on the Board of Works.

Survivors include two sons - Charlie (Judy) Cox, D.D.S. of Marion and Sterling (Donna Robinson) Cox of Warren; one brother - Melvin Cox of Huntington; six sisters - Amel Coburn of Albion, Elizabeth Girolami of Hamilton, Ohio, Shannon (Floyd) Miller of Avilla, Catherine (Edsel) Childers of Albion, Norma Gwen (Larry) Pant of Kendalville and Anne Mae (Monte) Conley of Kendalville; six grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren. A special friend - Aretta Scheiber and her family, including five children and ten grandchildren, also survive. His parents, wife, brothers - Carl Cox, Bill Cox and George Cox

and sister - Fern Gillenwater, preceded him in death.

Visitation will be 4 - 7 p.m. Tuesday (April 12, 2011) at the Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday (April 13, 2011) at the Christ the King Episcopal Church, 1224 N. Jefferson St. with Rev. M. Richard Miller officiating.
