November 28, 1920 - January 2, 2012

Charlotte E. Singer, age 91, of Huntington, died at 11:10 p.m. Monday (January 2, 2012) at Norwood Health & Rehabilitation in Huntington.

Charlotte was born on November 28, 1920, in Huntington, the daughter of Benjamin and Anna (Orr) Snowden. She was a 1938 graduate of Huntington High School and attended Olivet Nazarene College, Bourbonnais, Illinois. Charlotte married Welcome B. Singer on April 9, 1939 in Huntington. He preceded her in death on March 18, 2011.

Mrs. Singer retired as a financial aide coordinator for Huntington College after 20 years of service. She was also an independent Shaklee Products distributor. Charlotte was a member of First Church of the Nazarene in Huntington.

Survivors include one daughter - Sharon Elaine (Gail) Hubbart of Battlefield, Missouri; one son - Kirk Alan (Vickie) Singer of Leland, North Carolina; four brothers - Jack (Maradel) Snowden of Huntington, Gene (Carol) Snowden of Huntington, Ned (Mary) Snowden of Muncie and Jerry (Sharon) Snowden of Florida; five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. Her parents, husband, brother - Charles Snowden, and son - Terry Wayne Singer, preceded her in death.
