



## Chlora D. "Diane" Johnson

September 10, 1941 - January 12, 2018

Chlora Diane Johnson, 76, of Huntington, died Friday, Jan. 12, 2018, at 11:46 p.m. at Norwood Health and Rehabilitation Center, in Huntington.

Mrs. Johnson graduated from Granger High School in Salt Lake City, UT, where she was active in chorus, Commercial Club, Pep Club and Future Homemakers of America; she was a founding member of the Accolade literary magazine. She attended LDS Business College in Salt Lake City, UT, and Utah State University in Logan, UT. She served a mission in Jacksonville, FL, for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, of which she was a lifelong member. In her varied career, she did administrative work for David O. McKay, (then the President of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints), a power company, a law firm and a relay service for the hearing impaired. She was a medical transcriptionist for 15 years until her retirement in 2010.

She was born Sept. 10, 1941, in Salt Lake City, UT, to Jack and Chlora Draxler. Her father is deceased. Her mother survives in North Logan, UT. She married David Russell Johnson, Sr. on Jan. 16, 1971, in Salt Lake City, UT. He preceded her in death on Dec. 31, 2014.

Additional survivors include seven children, Trudy (Clay) Poole and Cheryl (Evan) Larsen of Tacoma, WA; David (Stephenie) Johnson, Jr. and Scott

(Jennifer) Johnson of Portland, OR; Sonja Johnson and Gwen (Chris) Beluschak of Huntington; and Colleen Johnson of St. Petersburg, FL. She is mourned by a surviving brother, Jack (Marilyn) Draxler of North Logan, UT. Her sister, Linda Koch, preceded her in death. She has 9 grandchildren, Rozi and Lewis Larsen, Camille and Trent Dawson, Adam, Sophia and Henry Beluschak and Gavin and Josie Johnson.
