



## Christina K. "Tina" Haynes

November 19, 1968 - March 31, 2020

Christina K. "Tina" Haynes, age 51, of Roanoke, died at 2:45 p.m. Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at her home surrounded by her friends and family.

Private services will be held with burial following in Pilgrims Rest Cemetery in Huntington.

Christina was born on November 19, 1968 in Fort Wayne, the daughter of Edward Gordon "Corky" and Birdie Kathryn (Robison) Swain. She graduated from Huntington North High School in 1987 and earned a bachelor's degree from The University of St. Francis in Fort Wayne in 1999. Christina married Willis H. Haynes on April 12, 2008 in Roanoke. She worked as a registered nurse for Humana for six years and was a member of The Chapel in Fort Wayne. She dearly loved her family.

Survivors include her husband, Willis Haynes of Roanoke, her mother, Birdie Swain of Columbia City, daughters Katrisha (Ryan) Stutzman of Edgerton, Ohio and Abbygail Haynes of Roanoke, her son, Justin (Jennifer) Waikel of Fort Wayne, a brother David (Shelley) Swain of Roanoke. 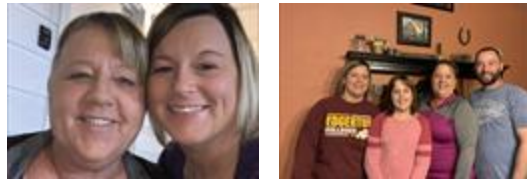

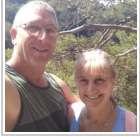
