Christopher A. Urschel, 65, of Huntington, passed away at 5:02 am Saturday, August 10, 2024.

Chris was born on October 8, 1958, in Wabash, IN, the son of Marion “Junior” Urschel and Susan (Lancaster) Urschel. He graduated from Huntington North High School with the class of 1977 and continued his education at Ivy Tech where he earned his associates degree. Chris married his true love Rena Kay Keller on November 8, 1980, in Yoder, IN. They shared 43 years of marriage before she recently preceded him in death on July 13, 2024.

He was a member of the Single Action Shooting Society for over 25 years and member of the NRA. Chris was a faithful member of the New Hope United Church of Christ in Bippus, IN. He served on several boards for the community and currently was serving on the Bippus Regional Sewer District board.
