Clarence E. Bell, age 87, of Huntington, died at 12:42 p.m. Wednesday (May 18, 2016) at Tipton Place in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 4 - 7 p.m. Monday (May 23, 2016) at Evangelical United Methodist Church, 1000 Flaxmill Road, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday (May 24, 2016) at Evangelical United Methodist Church with Rev. Richard Bunnell officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Pilgrims Rest Cemetery in Huntington.

Clarence was born on June 8, 1928 in Hartford City, the son of Tom and Orpha (Jones) Bell. He served in United States Army in the 101st Airborne Division during the Korean War. He married Barbara A. Frewer on April 13, 1952 in Huntington. In 1994, he retired from MacAllister Machinery in Fort Wayne, where he worked in the truck engine department for 11 years. Prior he worked at Thermtron Products in Fort Wayne for 14 years and Crew's Motors in Huntington for 17 years. Clarence was a member of Bethel United Methodist Church in Huntington and enjoyed woodworking and spending time

with his grandchildren.

Survivors include his wife of 64 years - Barbara A. Bell of Huntington; a son - Steven (Jane) Bell of Huntington; a daughter - Susan Ann (Charles) Denbo of Huntington; six grandchildren, and nine great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents, five brothers - Clifford Bell, John Bell, DeWayne Bell, Jack Bell, Thomas Richard Bell, and three sisters - Phyllis Hamilton, Charlotte Reff, and Lucille Waters.

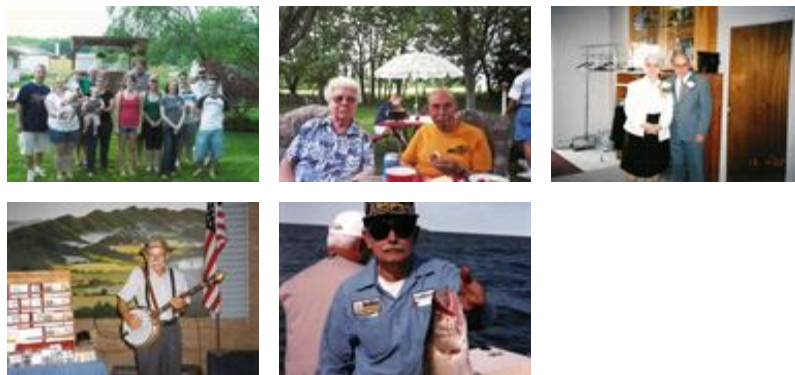
