Crow Junior Nelson, 77, of Huntington, passed away at 8:55 am Wednesday, September 21, 2022 at his residence.

Crow was born on November 10, 1944 in Prestonsburg, Kentucky, the son of Otis "Crow" Nelson and Belva (Webb) Nelson. He married the love of his life, Sue Ann on July 31, 1964 in North Manchester, IN. They shared nearly 58 years of marriage before she preceded him in death on May 29, 2022. He retired from the railroad after 30 years of service.
