Darl D. Caley, age 78, Huntington, died at 8:30 a.m. Friday (July 10, 2009) at his home.

He was born on July 24, 1930 in Wells County, Indiana, the son of Lloyd and Vera (Schoeff) Caley. Darl graduated from Huntington High School in 1948 and served in the Air Force from 1950-1954. He married Jean M. McInnis on March 31, 1954 in Bangor Maine. Darl was the owner of Caley's Servicenter in Huntington for 43 years, retiring in 1998. He also worked with his father at the Geede-Corey Hardware Store in Huntington from 1954-1973. Darl was a member of the V.F.W. Post #2689 and Masonic Lodge #483 F & A.M.

Survivors include his wife of 55 years – Jean M. Caley of Huntington; two sons – Steve Caley of Atlanta, Georgia and Gregg Caley of Fort Wayne, Indiana; one daughter – Pam Hesting of Huntington; one brother – Duwane Caley of Huntington; one sister – Bonnie Ostrow of Huntington; and six grandchildren – Ryan Caley, Megan Caley, David Caley, Tim Hesting, Matt Hesting and Laura Hesting. He is preceded in death by his parents.
