David Russell Johnson, Sr., 77, of Huntington, died Wednesday, Dec. 31, 2014, at 2:35 p.m. at Norwood Health and Rehabilitation Center, in Huntington.

Mr. Johnson graduated from Camas High School in Camas, WA, where he was active in 4H, speech and debate, drama, baseball, football and track and field. He attended Clark College in Vancouver, WA, and Portland State University in Portland, OR. He owned and operated Rite-Way Business Survey, a retail auditing firm serving the Pacific Northwest, until his retirement at age 66. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.
