Dean A. Hunter, age 92, of Huntington, died at 10:30 p.m. Friday, July 6, 2018 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Wednesday, July 11, 2018 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday, July 12, 2018 at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Jason Parsons and Pastor Mike Cloud officiating. 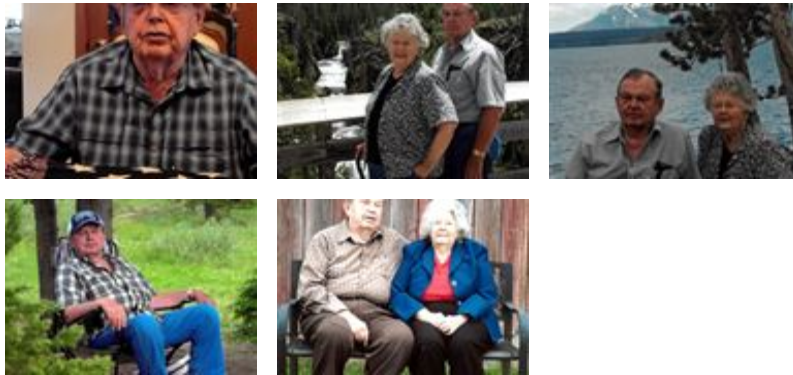
