Delbert Snow, age 79, Andrews, died at 6:35 p.m. Tuesday (September 22, 2009) in his home.

Delbert was born July 5, 1930 in Kalamazoo, Michigan to Thomas and Alien (Earl) Snow. He was the former owner of the Snow Construction Company in Andrews for many years, and had worked in Marion for the former Lingers and Bernie Winklers Construction Companies both of Marion. Delbert married Phyllis J. Tuggle on May 8, 1948 in Huntington and she survives.

Delbert was a member of the Andrews Christian Church and Life member of the Lagro American Legion #248. He was also an avid fisherman.

Survivors include his wife of 61 years – Phyllis J. Snow of Andrews, one son Robert E. (Gale) Snow of Uniondale; three daughters – Teresa A.
