Donald Ray Malone, 85, of Huntington, passed away at 9:30 am Saturday, October 2, 2021 at Lutheran Hospital, Ft. Wayne, IN due to injuries he sustained in a car accident.

Donald was born on November 6, 1935 in Sullivan, IN, the son of Ezra Malone and Mona (Vowell) Malone White. He graduated from Sullivan High School and attended Indiana State University. He married Anne E. Hildebrand on April 8, 1962 in Huntington, IN. Donald was a Veteran of the United States Army where he served as a Medic. He retired in 1994 as a Journeyman Press Operator from Our Sunday Visitor after 32 years of service.
