Donald E. Shank, age 83, of Huntington, died at 8:15 p.m. Wednesday (January 1, 2014) at his home.

Family will receive friends from 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Tuesday (January 7, 2014) at Huntington Church of the Nazarene, 1555 Flaxmill Road, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday (January 8, 2013) at Huntington Church of the Nazarene with one hour of visitation prior to the service. Pastor Keith White will be officiating. 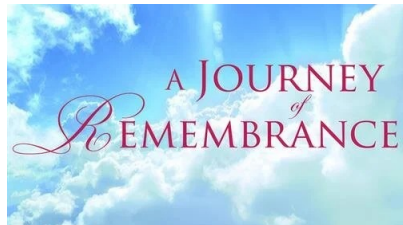
