Dorothy Rose Laughlin, age 90, of Wabash, formerly of Huntington, died at 5:06 a.m. Saturday (April 9, 2016) at Wellbrooke of Wabash.

Visitation will be from 9 - 10 a.m. Wednesday (April 13, 2016) at SS Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 860 Cherry Street, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will immediately follow at 10 a.m. Wednesday at SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church with Father Ron Reider officiating. Burial will be in Cedar Grove Cemetery in Notre Dame, Indiana at a later date.

Dorothy was a homemaker and a member of SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Huntington. She volunteered at the church food pantry and was a member of Psi Iota Xi. She was an avid gardener and a Starlight ballroom dancer. She loved to play bridge, enjoyed knitting, and was a season ticket holder for Notre Dame football for over 50 years.

Survivors include a son - Thomas J. Laughlin of South Bend; three daughters - Maureen Lester of Wabash, and Sheila (Philip) Neumann and Patricia Skelton, both of Bloomington; 12 grandchildren, and 9 great grandchildren. Her parents and husband precede her in death.
