



## Dorothy Gee Deemer

September 28, 1934 - November 12, 2009

Dorothy Gee Deemer, age 75, of Huntington, died at 9:00 p.m. Thursday (November 12, 2009) at Parkview Hospital in Fort Wayne.

Dorothy was born on September 28, 1934, in Huntington County, the daughter of Louis H. and Mabel V. (Garber) Gee. She graduated from the Huntington High School in 1952. Dorothy then married John E. Deemer on June 14, 1953 at the former Old Central Christian Church in Huntington.

Dorothy was a homemaker and retired in 1996 as manager of the Majestic Credit Union. She was a member of Central Christian Church, Historical Forks of the Wabash, Daughters of the American Revolution, Sigma Phi Gamma Sorority and the Star Light Dancers all of Huntington. Dorothy was active with the annual Pioneer Festival for many years performing spinning demonstrations.

Survivors include her husband of 56 years – John E. Deemer of Huntington; one daughter – Cynthia K. (Mark) Foust of Fort Wayne; two sisters – Martha (Roger) Barnhart of Churubusco and Linda L.
