



Dortha Eileen "Dottie" Watson

January 31, 1920 - June 7, 2011

Dortha Eileen "Dottie" (Hoss) Watson, age 91, of Huntington, died at 2:05 p.m. Tuesday (June 7, 2011) at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

Dottie was born on January 31, 1920, in Logansport, the daughter of Ray Lovell and Nora (Burket) Odell. She graduated from Crawfordsville High School in 1937. Her first marriage was to Isaac E. Hoss. He preceded her in death on January 25, 2006. In 1966, Dottie married Jay Watson in Lafayette and he preceded her in death in 2008.

Dottie retired as office manager for Alton Box Board Company where she worked for over 25 years. After moving to Huntington, she worked part time for Hiner Transport, Inc. Dottie was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church. She volunteered from 1989-1996 at the Vice Presidential Learning Center and Museum. Dottie was a member of the Forks of the Wabash Chapter ABWA, Psi Iota Xi Sorority, Huntington County Republican Women's Club and was the former treasurer of the Huntington County Republican Party.
