Douglas "Doug" Jay Fisher, 67, of Huntington, was welcomed into heaven by his son Mark, father, Delos and dog Bailey at 5:30 am Saturday, January 21, 2023, at Parkview Randallia Hospital in Fort Wayne, IN.

Doug was born on September 24, 1955, in Huntington, IN, the son of Delos Fisher and Andrea McIntosh. He graduated from Huntington North High School with the class of 1974.
