Earline J. Lowery, age 93, of Huntington, went home to be with the Lord at 1:21 a.m. Monday, January 21, 2019 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Earline was born on February 25, 1925 in Huntington County, the daughter of Howard and Mary (Brown) Dolby. She graduated from Lancaster Township School in 1943 and married Robert Allen Lowery on December 22, 1946. Earline was a homemaker. She farmed with her family on their Rock Creek Township farm for over 50 years. Earline also invested many years volunteering with the American Heart Association. She was a life-long member of Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church in Huntington County where she played the piano and organ for over 68 years.
