Echo June Swing, 102, of Huntington, passed away at 7:35 am Friday, April 4, 2025 at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

June was born on June 2, 1922 in Huntington County, IN, the daughter of Carl Morford and Ruth (Berkeypile) Morford. She graduated from Bippus High School with the Class of 1940 and married Rex D.
