December 12, 1931 - July 25, 2016

Edwin Gary Mygrant, age 84, of Huntington, died at 3:17 a.m. Monday, July 25, 2016 at Parkview Huntington Hospital.

A gathering of family and friends will be from 10 a.m. - 11 a.m. Saturday, July 30, 2016 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. A memorial service will immediately follow at 11 a.m. Saturday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. David Mygrant officiating.

Ed was born on December 12, 1931 in Huntington, the son of Russell and Ailene (Keller) Mygrant. He graduated from Huntington High School in 1950 and served in the United States Army as a Staff Sergeant during the Korean War. He married Donna Gahman on June 30, 1973 in Huntington. In 1987, after 30 years of service, Ed retired from Dana in Marion, where he served as the local union president during his tenure. He loved the horse races and the casino at Hoosier Park in Anderson.

Survivors include his wife of 43 years, Donna Mygrant of Huntington; two sons, Kevin Mygrant and Kyle (Tracy) Mygrant, both of Huntington; a brother, David (Barbara) Mygrant; two sisters, Joyce Piatt of Orlando, Florida and Nancy Voght of Huntington, and two grandchildren, Nathan Mygrant and Joshua Mygrant. His parents and sisters, Doris Slusser and Phyllis Catlin, precede him in death.

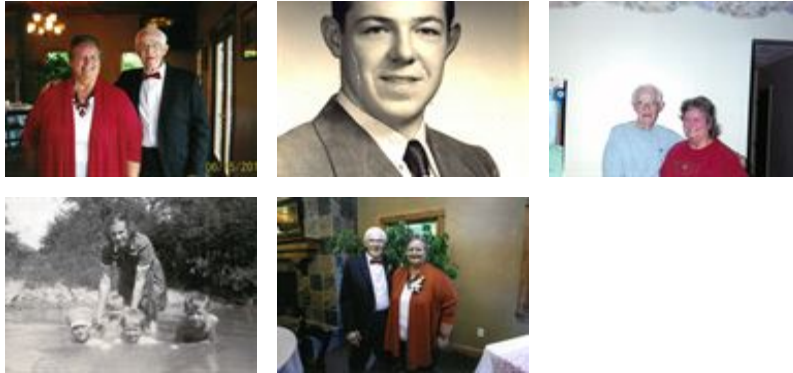
