Eileen L. Keiffer, age 88, of Huntington, died at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday (June 23, 2009) at the Heritage of Huntington.

Eileen was born on May 15, 1921 in Lancaster Township, to Everett E. and Myrtle M. (Fulton) Couch. She graduated from Lancaster High School in 1939. Eileen married Clyde M. Keiffer on March 7, 1940. She was a loving mother and homemaker. Eileen was a member of the Salamonie Church of the Brethren, past Matron of the Mount Etna Order of the Eastern Star, past President of the Huntington County Home Extension, and past Board Member of the Huntington County Red Cross.

Survivors include her husband of 69 years – Clyde M. Keiffer of Huntington; two sons – Larry M. (Joyce) Keiffer of Lafontaine, Indiana and Richard D. (Kittie) Keiffer of Huntington; six grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren. Her parents and two brothers – Charles E. Couch and Marvin C. Couch preceded her in death.

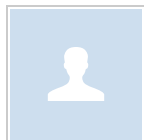

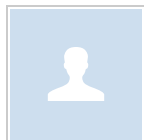
