Emily M. Michael, age 82, of Huntington, died at 8:10 p.m. Tuesday (June 28, 2011) at the Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Emily was born on December 7, 1928, in Daytona Beach, Florida, the daughter of William D. and Helen (vonJasmund) Murray. She was a 1946 graduate of Stephens Junior College in Columbia, Missouri. Emily attended DePauw University for three years where she met the love of her life, John V. Michael, Sr. They married on August 6, 1949 in Lawrenceburg and he preceded her in death on November 30, 1996.

Emily retired from the Huntington City Township Public Library as a Genealogy Secretary.

She was also a substitute teacher for the Huntington County Community School Corporation. Emily was a faithful member of Trinity United Methodist Church and served in the past on the Administration Board. She was a member of the Monday Club, Sorosis Club, Tri Kappa Sorority and the Book Club. Emily proudly served as a Hospice volunteer and the Stephens Ministry of Trinity.

Survivors include two sons - John V. (Sharon) Michael, Jr. of Fort Wayne and W. Murray (Kathleen) Michael of Searcy, Arkansas; one daughter - Tanner

Michael of Panama City, Florida; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. Her parents, husband and brother - William Dukes Murray (2005), preceded her in death.
