



Ethelmae "Alice" Flaughter

September 11, 1917 - December 25, 2010

Ethelmae "Alice" Flaughter, age 93, Fishers (formerly of Huntington), died at 10:17 p.m. Saturday (December 25, 2010) at Community Hospital North, Indianapolis.

Ethelmae was born September 11, 1917, in Knox County, the daughter of Chester and Elizabeth Mary (King) Charlton. She graduated from Carlisle High School in 1935 and received her Registered Nurse Degree, in 1938, from Good Samaritan Hospital in Vincennes. Ethelmae married Carl A. Flaughter on December 24, 1941 and he preceded her in death on August 22, 1967.

Ethelmae retired as school nurse for the Huntington County School Corporation. She also worked as a registered nurse at the Huntington Hospital in the OB and Nursery Departments and at Logansport Hospital prior to that. She was a member of Central Christian Church.

Survivors include one son – Charles L. "Lee" (Nancy Smith) Flaughter of Fishers; two sisters – Helen Snyder of Oaktown and Janet (Jim) Sheffler of Sullivan; five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Her parents, husband, daughter – Beth Ann McCord, and sisters – Virginia Daughty and June Deis, preceded her in death.

Visitation will be from 12 - 2 p.m. Friday (December 31, 2010) at the Bailey-Love Mortuary. Funeral Services will follow at 2 p.m. Friday (December 31, 2010) at the Bailey-Love Mortuary with Dr. Sam Young officiating. Burial will be in the Beech Grove Cemetery, Huntington County.

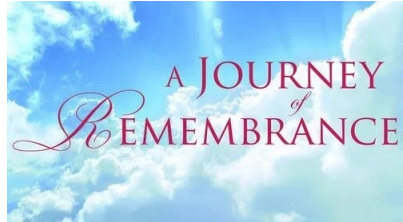
