October 6, 1920 - April 30, 2012

Eugene Harold Warner, age 91, of Huntington, passed at 2:00 a.m. Monday (April 30, 2012) at his residence.

Eugene was born October 6, 1920 in South Whitley, the son of Lloyd and Edna (Austin) Warner. He graduated from South Whitley High School in 1938. He was with the United States Army from 1941 to 1945 as First Lieutenant serving in the South Pacific in World War II.

Eugene married Mary Wood Parrett on June 30, 1960 and lived in Florida for a few years then moved back to Huntington. Mary preceded him in death October 9, 1979.

He retired in 1978 from Memcor E-Systems in Huntington after serving as supervisor for 22 years. Eugene was a life member of the V.F.W. Post# 2689 in Huntington and the American Legion Post# 160 in Roanoke. Eugene was a History Buff and loved to "box garden"... growing plants and veggie's in boxes.

Survivors include his three stepsons - Kenneth (Melba) Parrett of Huntington, David (Dianne) Parrett of Huntington and Mark (Sylvia) Parrett of Huntington, eight grandchildren, twenty great-grandchildren, two great great-grandchildren, one niece and three nephews. His parents, wife, brothers -
