Evelyn Ruth Teddy, 84, of South Bend, formerly of Huntington, passed away at 7:40 am Friday, September 12, 2025, at Healthwin Health & Rehabilitation in South Bend, Indiana.

Evelyn was born on December 16, 1940, in Cincinnati, OH, the daughter of Edward Bruner and Evangeline (Pohlman) Bruner. She graduated from Pueblo High School in Phoenix AZ with the class of 1958. Evelyn married Fred A. Teddy on December 21, 1968, in Huntington, IN; he preceded her in death on January 13, 2013, after 44 years of marriage.

Evelyn retired from Madison Center working as a Mental Health Technician. Prior to that, she was a Case Manager at Bowen Center. In the 70's, Evelyn was the first female foreman at Majestic here in Huntington, she was very proud to hold that title.
