Everett L. Clements, age 87, of Huntington, died at 4:45 a.m. Wednesday, November 28, 2018 at Woodview Memory Care in Fort Wayne.

Graveside services will be at 3 p.m. Friday, November 30, 2018 in St. Peter's First Cemetery in Huntington, Indiana with Rev. Raymond Scribner officiating and military graveside rites performed by the United States Navy and Masonic rites performed by Mt. Etna Masonic Lodge.
