Frederick H. Rudig, age 85, Huntington, died at 2:00 a.m. Thursday (May 3, 2012) at his residence in Huntington, Indiana.

Frederick was born on December 27, 1926 to Herman Adam and Ethel Marie (Coopenhaver) Rudig in Huntington County. He graduated in 1945 from Huntington High School and attended Indiana University for 2 years. Frederick was a veteran of the Army and served in WW II. He married Elizabeth Canvin on April 8, 1950 in Huntington. She preceded him in death on May 25, 1996.

Frederick retired from General Motors in Marion after serving 31 years as a tool and die maker. He also worked for Dana Corporation in Fort Wayne for 10 years. He is a member of the Huntington county Modelers Club, the V.F.W Post #2689 in Huntington and Central Christian Church in Huntington.

Frederick loved to build and fly radio-controlled airplanes, he enjoyed golfing and also deep sea fishing.

He is survived by his son - Donald C. (Karla) Rudig of Huntington; a daughter - Debbie Rudig of Markle; a sister - Margaret "Peg" Stoffel of Huntington; two grandchildren and a great-grandchild.
