Frieda M. Ulm, age 91, of Huntington, died at 10:20 p.m. Wednesday, December 20, 2017 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

knitting and spent the last nine years of her life at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

She is survived by two daughters - Roma (Gary) White of Markle and Rowena (Timothy) Richardson of Huntington; a daughter-in-law - Connie Lawrence of Fort Wayne; a sister - Patricia (George) Krieg of Warren; five grandchildren, ten great grandchildren, two great-great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, her son, Ronald D. Lawrence, and a sister, Mary Evelyn Lewis.

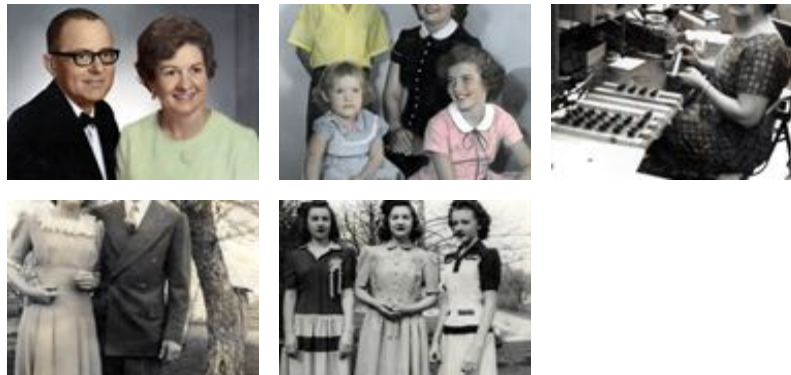
