Gary Wayne Miller, age 64, of Huntington, passed at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday (July 24, 2012) at his residence.

Gary was born February 11, 1948 in Muncie, Indiana, the son of Vaughn and June (Tesch) Miller. He graduated in 1966 from Selma High School before entering the military. He was a veteran ranked E-5 of the United States Army. He married Diadra Ohrvall on November 3, 1973 in Gaston, Indiana.
